

# UNIFORM REGULATIONS

The College uniform must be worn neatly and correctly at all times, even when out in public. You are a representative of the College when in uniform.

## Neatness and Grooming

- Students must wear the correct and complete College uniform to and from school
- The uniform must be kept clean, well pressed and in good repair
- Shirts must be tucked in
- Dresses and skirts to be worn at knee length
- All items of clothing to be the correct size and length
- The tie is to be tied correctly with top button done up.
- Shorts and trousers are to be correctly belted and worn at the waist
- Female students are to ensure that their undergarments cannot be seen through their blouse
- Only plain white singlets/T-shirts may be worn under the school shirt
- Girls' tights are to be ladder-free (These can also be purchased from the Canteen)

## Blazer

- The blazer must be worn to and from school (Terms 2 and 3)
- The blazer must be worn to PCG and to every lesson. It may be taken off once in class.
- The blazer may be required on special occasions in Terms 1 and 4

## Casual Dress Days

- This is usually associated with fundraising
- Students who participate usually donate \$2, those who come in Sport Uniform donate \$1 and those who chose to wear College uniform pay nothing
- No mid-riffs are to be exposed
- Skirts and shorts to be no shorter than mid thigh
- Revealing tops are not permitted
- Messages and symbols on clothing that are against the College ethos are not acceptable

## Hair

- Hair should be neatly combed or brushed
- Where it touches the collar, it is to be tied back
- Hair must be kept off the face
- Hair is not to be cut shorter than a Number 2
- Use of hair products must be kept to a minimum
- Only College coloured ribbons, combs or headbands (red, green, yellow) to be worn
- Extreme hairstyles (for example, undercuts, beaded braids, dreadlocks, rat's tails), unnatural tints and streaks are NOT permitted
- Boys are to be clean-shaven at school and College functions.
- Side burns should not exceed mid-ear length

## Jewellery (Only these items permitted)

- One small Christian cross or medallion on a chain
- One small earring in each ear lobe.
- No other piercings permitted
- One plain band or signet ring
- Wrist watch
- The College accepts no responsibility for loss of, or damage to, items of jewellery at school

## Makeup

- A small amount of concealer of a natural colour is permitted.
- No other makeup or nail polish permitted.

## Physical and Outdoor Education

- Be sun smart when engaged in outdoor activities
- Bring your PE gear in the College sports bag
- Students will not be permitted to participate in incorrect uniform
- College tracksuit is to be worn over the sport uniform if cold. The College jumper is NOT to be worn with the PE uniform
- House shirts must be worn for all House activities and inter-House carnivals only

## Representative Sport (ACC Carnivals)

- Students must wear the green and gold sport shirt with College crest
- College football socks for those representing the College in football, soccer or hockey
- Regulation green Speedos. Students are NOT permitted to wear Taslon shorts over the bathers

## Incorrect/Incomplete uniform

- Any simple uniform discrepancies (e.g., no blazer, wrong shoes) requires a note from parent/guardian and must be signed by the PCA
- If an emergency arises and the majority of the correct uniform cannot be worn, students may wear full and correct sports uniform accompanied by a note from parent/guardian and presented to the relevant Year Coordinator upon arrival at school.
