

Mr Rod Evans, Director of Ideas 2 Results, presented an informative lesson on how to write really good business plans. He showed how business plans that use pictures and simple, concise text will convey the information in a clear and easy to read format for all stakeholders. Mr Evans recounted the recent growth of Alinta Limited. This company used a diagrammatic business plan to take it from a small West Australian utility to a top 50 company in Australia!



Owner of The Jungle Body® - Mrs Tara Simich (nee Franzinelli) and La Salle College Head Girl in 2007, spoke to students about her background, ideas for a fitness company and use of a business plan to steer her ideas to become reality. In 3 short years her company has grown from 20 to 310 instructors who deliver choreographed 'exercise to music' group fitness classes in 7 countries around the globe! Tara spoke of her involvement as a student in all that College life had to offer, which was instrumental in her successes. She not only captivated the students with her business acumen, but also engaged them in an 'exercise to music' routine, which saw everyone up and out of their seats.

The students and I would sincerely like to thank our presenters, Mr Rod Evans and Mrs Tara Simich for generously giving their time and sharing their business expertise with the students. I am sure that these lessons will be remembered long after the students leave La Salle College.

YEAR 8/9 BASKETBALL






