School Colours

La Salle College Middle Swan uniform features the College crest made up of green, gold and red.

Our Uniform

La Salle College students wear their uniform proudly at all times. The College uniform embodies a practical commitment to striving for excellence in everything we do.

Regular reviews of the uniform and related guidelines are undertaken to ensure it:

- Represents the College positively in the community
- Students are proud to wear it
- Enables recognition and promotes safety
- Features choice and options are inclusive of all students.

Uniforms are also worn when representing the College in music, sport and during extracurricular activities.

Our Shop

All uniform items can be purchased from the College Uniform Shop. Opening hours are Monday and Wednesday from 7:30am to 1:30pm and Tuesday 7:30am to 9:00am during Term time.

Items can also be purchased by completing an order form that is available in the Getting Through the Day section of the College's Parent Hub and emailing the form to uniform_shop@lasalle.wa.edu.au. You may also phone through your order or enquiry on 9449 0624.

Orders can be either picked up from the Uniform Shop during opening hours or by calling the Uniform Shop for alternative arrangements.

Shirt

The formal white shirt with the La Salle College crest can be worn all year round. In summer it is worn tucked in with the College grey shorts and in winter, College grey trousers or skirt. A tie must be worn with the winter uniform.

Trousers/Shorts

The only style permitted, is regulation grey school trousers or shorts which must be worn correctly belted (where appropriate) at the waist. Belts should be grey or black with a nondescript buckle. These styles are available in the Uniform Shop.

Skirt/Dress

The grey skirt is worn as part of the winter uniform with grey opaque tights. The green College dress is worn in summer with white College ankle socks. Appropriate length regulation is that the hem sits at mid-knee length.

Blazer

The green College blazer with embroidered crest is the official clothing item of the winter uniform and must be worn to and from school and all classes, during PCG and during assembly in Term 2 and 3. It may also be required for formal College events such as Presentation Evening.

Red Jumper

The College red jumper is an optional clothing item that can be worn in summer or winter for additional warmth.



Tie

The College tie is striped and worn in Year 7 - 11. A green senior tie with College crest is worn in Year 12. The tie is to be correctly tied with the top shirt button done up.

Shoes

Traditional black leather lace-up school shoes, with a low heel must be worn. Black sneakers, skate shoes, flat-soled and sandals are not permitted. Sports sneakers are to be worn with the Physical Education (PE) uniform. No skate style sneakers or canvas, flat soled shoes are to be worn.

Socks/Tights

White College socks should be worn with the green College dress. Grey opaque tights should be worn with the grey skirt. Socks and tights cannot be worn together. Grey socks are to be worn with the College trousers or shorts. White College sports socks are to be worn with the PE uniform.

House Shirt

The House shirt may be worn as an alternative to the College sports shirt for PE classes. On House Days, students can wear their House shirt with the College green microfibre sports short.

Tracksuit/Sports Shorts

The College tracksuit is green and is a required uniform item. Students must wear this, not the College jumper over their sports uniform if they are cold. The College tracksuit top is not to be worn with the formal uniform or under the blazer. Green microfibre sports shorts are to be worn with the gold College sports polo for PE and Outdoor Education.

Sports and Outdoor Education

The gold College sports polo, green microfibre sports shorts or green tracksuit may be worn for PE and Outdoor Education classes. The regulation green bathers are to be worn for swimming.

Students must wear their academic uniform to and from school every day. Students are required to bring their sports clothes to PE and Outdoor Education classes in the College sports bag. Students will not be allowed to participate in sport if they are wearing the incorrect uniform. College hats are compulsory during outdoor activities.

College Hat

As a sun-smart College, the green College cap or bucket hat is an essential item of the uniform. Hats are compulsory for outside activities and during recess and lunch.

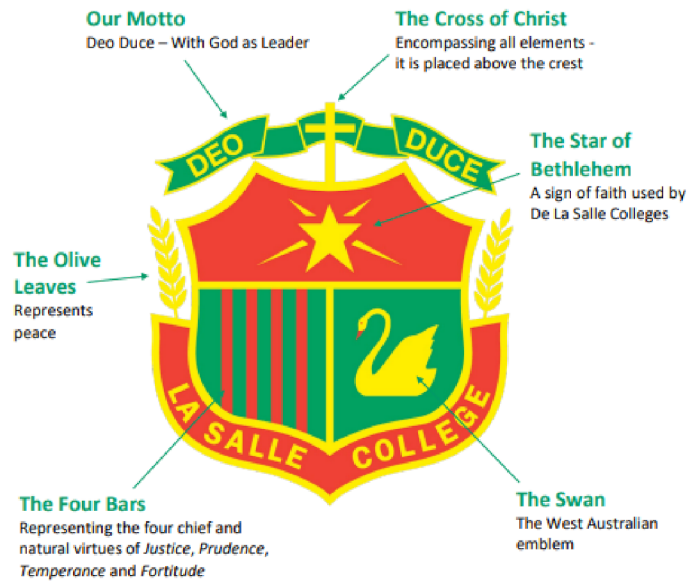
Lost Property

All items of clothing should be clearly marked for ease of identification if lost. The College does not accept responsibility for lost property.

Makeup/Nails

Foundation may be worn (natural appearance only). Eye shadow, mascara, blush, eyeliner and lipstick are not to be worn. Nails are to be natural (Nail polish, Gel or Acrylic etc. is not permitted). Eyelash extensions and enhanced eyebrows are not permitted.

Hair

Hair standards are set for student safety and the avoidance of excessive display.

- Hair should be of neat appearance.
- Hair may be cut no shorter than a Number 2.
- Hair touching the collar is to be tied back neatly using elastic bands or scrunchies in the school colours. Black and brown elastics and headbands in school colours are also permitted.
- A gradual blending of lengths between sides, top and back is required. Extreme hairstyles and colours are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Undercuts
 - Mullets
 - Rat's-tails
 - Beaded braids
 - Unnatural tints, streaks and root colour
- Excessive use of hair products is not permitted.
- Boys are to be clean-shaven at school and functions.
- Side burn length should not exceed mid-ear length.

Jewellery

Jewellery standards are set for student safety and the avoidance of excessive display.

The following basic jewellery can be worn:

- One small Christian cross or medallion on a chain around the neck and under the shirt or dress.
- Wristwatch.
- One plain band or signet ring.
- One set of small gold or silver studs or sleeper earrings (one in each earlobe).
- Sleepers should be no larger than 12mm in diameter with no adornments or attachments.
- Studs with a small crystal/clear gem.

No other ear or facial piercings are permitted. Tape covering inappropriate piercings is not permitted.
