

# BYOD Program

La Salle College is a 1:1 notebook computer school, with all students being required to have a suitable device. It is anticipated that students will update their device every three years (i.e. first device for Years 7 to 9; second device for Years 10 to 12), however, a device can be purchased at any time. This letter serves to give relevant information in regard to this. In order to ensure all students have access to computer technologies the College has a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) program. There are two methods by which students can obtain a notebook computer:

## 1. School Managed BYOD

- a. The College will seek quotations yearly for the supply of a suitable notebook computer
- b. The chosen supplier, notebook specifications and method of purchase will be forwarded to parents (see preferred supplier on page 3).
- c. Purchasing from this supplier will have the following benefits:
  - The notebook computer will meet all educational requirements and will be guaranteed to operate on the College network
  - A 3 year warranty is included and also a 3 year ADP (Accidental Damage Protection) coverage (conditions apply).
  - The College's ICT Service Department will handle all Warranty and ADP claims.
  - A limited number of loan devices will be available to students who have notebooks in for warranty claims. Any damage incurred whilst on loan will attract an excess payment.

## 2. Parent Managed BYOD

- a. Parents can purchase any Windows based device, which meets the educational and technical requirements of the College
- b. Required specifications:
  - **Windows 10/11 Pro** operating system
  - 5Ghz Wi-Fi chip set
  - Screen size: 10" minimum
  - Battery: 6-hour minimum battery life
  - SSD hard drive
- c. Recommended specifications:
  - Minimum of 4 GB RAM
  - 128 GB hard drive or larger
  - 3 year warranty
  - 3 year ADP (Accidental Damage Protection)
- d. The ICT Service Department will make every effort to ensure that parent supplied devices can connect to the College network and remain fully functional. However, they will not be able to (as these will remain parent responsibilities):
  - Make any hardware repairs
  - Install driver or other software updates
  - Process any warranty or ADP claims
  - Make loan devices available.

## Advantages of BYOD

Each student will have personal access to a computer as required. The inequity of digital resources will, therefore, no longer be an issue for our students as they will have a device which can be used at school as well as at home.

## Responsibilities

1. The parents/guardians own the notebook computer and can therefore install software, printer drivers and make network connections in order to ensure full functionality within the home environment.
2. The students will need to assume responsibility for the device to ensure it is fully functional for the time it is at the College. These responsibilities will include:
  - Charging the device each night, as no access to power will be available at school
  - Ensuring no malware, viruses, or other programmes which can adversely affect the College system are on the computer
  - Exercising due care and diligence so that warranty and ADP claims are not invalidated
  - Note, For ADP claims:
    - Only one claim per component (screen + external + internal) can be made per 12 month period (not cumulative)
    - Cover may be invalidated if the computer is not cared for with due diligence
  - Adhering to the College ICT policy as outlined in the College Organiser.

Whilst at the College access to the internet and other data will be filtered and monitored according to the College ICT policy. When the notebook is used at home it becomes the parents'/guardians' responsibility to supervise and monitor the use.



## Distribution

All devices (together with any optional accessories) ordered through the preferred supplier CDM Australia can be picked up from CDM or home delivered (if this is selected, at an additional cost).
